

The 2024 facilities referendum will address much-needed renovations and additions at the High School and Middle School building. These project components include adding Career and Technical Education spaces at the High School and creating a safe and secure High School entrance, improving technology infrastructure in the High School and Middle School, replacing the 1960s-era High School kitchen, cafeteria, and locker rooms, and renovating the existing High School kitchen, cafeteria, and locker rooms into classroom space and a community fitness center.

### The top priority in the Strategic Plan was to address facilities:

- Many of the projects included in the referendum will tackle our most pressing facility concerns while also preparing us for the next 20+ years.

### Following the Strategic Plan, the district developed a 10-year facilities plan to address aging facilities:

- The district has addressed many different facilities issues in the past few years, but these needs exceed what the district can do without the help of the taxpayers in the form of a referendum.
- Survey in the spring of 2024 asking community to prioritize different projects and the tax impact that would be tolerable.
- Current referendum reflects the results of the survey.
- Projects included in referendum were the projects with the highest priority score on the referendum.
- Dollar ask in the referendum is a reflection of the dollar amount the survey stated the community would support.

▶ If the referendum is successful, taxes would increase by **\$17 for every \$100,000** of property value.
